

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE MADISON  
COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION  
NOVEMBER 29, 2017**

A public meeting of the Madison County Election Commission was duly held and conducted at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 29, 2017, in Court Room 2 in the Madison County Courthouse in the City of Canton, Mississippi. The meeting was conducted during the public canvassing of affidavit ballots the day following the run-off election for a position on the Board of Trustees of the Canton Public School District. The following Commissioners were present:

District Three Commissioner Pat Truesdale  
District Four Commissioner Azzie Jackson-Adams  
District Five Commissioner Leroy Lacy

Commissioner Julia Hodges and Commissioner Jenkins were involved in the processing of ballots the night before but had to be out of town due to family and work commitments during the processing of the remaining affidavit ballots. Commission Attorney Spence Flatgard was also present.

Commissioner Lacy called the meeting to order. The Commission reviewed the affidavit ballots offered following their review of whether the voters were registered at an address within the added territory of the Canton Public School District. Upon a motion by Commissioner Truesdale and a second by Commissioner Jackson-Adams, the Commission accepted by a unanimous vote twenty-two (22) affidavit ballots to bring the final vote total as follows:

Courtney Rainey	562
Peter Brown	365

There being no pending ballots requiring voter identification, the Commission announced all proper votes had been counted. The Commission sealed the election materials to be delivered to the Circuit Clerk and began the certification process. The meeting was adjourned by unanimous consent.
