

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, G. P. COOK, a resident of Madison County, Mississippi, above the age of twenty-one years and of sound, disposing mind and memory, hereby make, publish and declare this my Last Will and Testament, hereby specifically revoking any and all other instruments of like nature and codicils thereto, heretofore made or purporting to have been made, by me.

ITEM I.

I have made different gifts to my beloved wife, Florence N. Cook, from time to time, as have others, which she can designate. I mention this only to make certain all such gifts shall be excluded from my estate.

ITEM II.

To her I bequeath the sum of \$40,000.00 in cash or Certificates of Deposit; any and all interest I may have in such gifts as have been made to us jointly through the years; the following furniture in our residence: Breakfast Room table and chairs, one Living Room end table, two Living Room lamp tables and the lamps thereon; and the following articles: Silver Set and Dining Room table cloth.

ITEM III.

I consider the above bequests to be a fair share of my estate and adequate to take care of her comfortably for the remainder of her life. But, without any limitation or restriction on those bequests, I hope however it will be her pleasure to bequeath one-half of what is left of this bequest to her sister Helen, if living, and divide the other half equally among her two brothers, Howard and Ben, and my three sons, Gilbert, Jr., William Lewis and Woodrow Edsel.

I mention my three sons in this connection because of the uncertainty of what may develop in the business world before they have disposed of the net realty which they will receive under ITEM IX hereinafter.

ITEM IV.

To each of my ten Grandchildren of the first generation, Gilbert Lewis Cook,
Peggy C. Morvant, Roger Cook; Norma Lynn Hartwig, Kathy Cook, William L. Cook, Jr.,
and Douglas Gilbert Cook; and Beckie Cook, Walter Edsel Cook and Daniel Cook, I
bequeath \$1,000.00 each. Those of said Grandchildren who have attained their majority
or are as much as 18 years old and married at the time of my death may receive their

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respective bequests promptly. The bequests to those then under 21 years of age and not married may be paid to Guardians or placed in Trust Deposits, as may be determined by the Court.

ITEM V.

To my Daughters-in-Law Virginia W. Cook, Ruth R. Cook and Annie Ruth Cook, I bequeath all household furniture remaining after that bequeathed to my wife, such items to be allotted to each in shares to be as nearly equal as possible according to value, between the three families. This involves their own needs and the needs of their children. In any question arising in making such division, the decision of any two mothers shall control, though the three sons might be helpful in determining the values of different items.

ITEM VI.

To my brother, Holoman Cook, and my sisters, Earl C. Hastings, Lena May Brignac and Launo C. Hannah, I bequeath \$1,000.00 each, provided if any one of them shall have predeceased me, the bequest to him or her shall go to the child or children of such decedent, and if there should be no child or children, shall go to the estate of the decedent.

ITEM VII.

I bequeath to Martha Moody Brignac, daughter of my deceased sister, Bell C. Moody, \$500.00.

ITEM VIII.

The residue of my estate consisting principally of the remaining acres in the Subdivision, the 165-acre farm left on Bear Creek, the "Taylor Place" (farm) near Vaughan, the one-half interest in realty at Meridian joint with Edsel, the Apartment House on Academy Street in Canton, the Residence on 16 Highway East, and the small investment in Co-operative Stocks and notes, after the satisfaction of the foregoing bequests and the administration of my estate, I devise and bequeath, share and share alike, to my three sons, Gilbert P. Cook, Jr., William Lewis Cook and Woodrow Edsel Cook. Should any of my said sons have predeceased me, his share shall go to his heirsat-law. 



I, ALMA S. LEVY, of said State and County, do make and publish this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills and Codicils heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE

- (a) I wish my body buried in a suitable manner and a suitable memorial erected and the cost thereof paid out of my estate.
- (b) All of my just debts and any unpaid charitable pledges whether such pledges are legally enforceable or not, shall be paid out of my estate as soon as practicable.
- (c) Debts, taxes, expenses of administration and similar charges shall be paid out of the residue of my estate.

ITEM TWO

- (a) I hereby constitute and appoint as Executor of this Will my son, ALVIN W. LEVY. If for any reason he should fail to qualify or should cease or be unable to serve in this capacity hereunder, then I constitute and appoint as Executor of this Will my son, LOUIS K. LEVY. If for any reason he should fail to qualify or should cease or be unable to serve in this capacity hereunder, then I constitute and appoint as Executor of this Will my grandson, BERTRAM L. LEVY.
- (b) I hereby constitute and appoint as Trustees of any and all trusts created under this Will my sons, ALVIN W. LEVY and LOUIS K. LEVY. If for any reason ALVIN W. LEVY or LOUIS K. LEVY should fail to qualify or should cease or be unable to serve in this capacity hereunder, then I constitute and appoint as Trustee

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the other to serve as sole Trustee. If both ALVIN W. LEVY and LOUIS K. LEVY should fail to qualify or should cease or be unable to serve in this capacity hereunder, then I constitute and appoint as Trustee my grandson, BERTRAM L. LEVY.

- (c) No successor Executor or Trustee shall be required to inquire into or audit the acts or doings of any predecessor Executor or Trustee or make any claim against such predecessor Executor or Trustee or his or her estate.
- (d) Any successor Executor or Trustee shall have and may exercise any or all of the powers herein conferred on my Executor or Trustee as fully and to the same extent as if such successor had originally been named as Executor or Trustee herein.
- (e) Singular forms of the words "Trustee", "Executor" and "Executrix" used herein shall include their plural forms if more than one fiduciary is serving. Plural forms of the word "Trustee" used herein shall include its singular form if only one fiduciary is serving. Similarly, pronouns shall be deemed to include masculine, feminine, or neuter forms in order to reflect the gender of the fiduciary then serving.

ITEM THREE

All my household furniture and furnishings, books, pictures, objects of art, silverware, jewelry, clothing and other such personal effects and any automobiles I may own at the time of my death, I give and bequeath to my Executor to distribute in such a manner as he in his sole discretion may decide. If I have left with my personal papers or with my Executor a list of certain specific items of personal property which I would like for certain named persons to have at my death, it is my wish (but not my direction), that my Executor will honor my wishes.

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ITEM FOUR

- (a) I give, devise, and bequeath to the Trustees named above as Trustees the following property:
 - (1) \$15,000 Virginia Electric Light and Power Company 9% Bond;
 - (2) My interest in Empire State Building Associates;
 - (3) My interest in Equitable Building Associates;
 - (4) My interest in Garment Capitol Associates;
 - (5) My interest in Lincoln Building Associates;
 - (6) 1,000 shares of National Service Industries common stock.

If any of the above named property is sold or exchanged by me prior to my death, my Executor is hereby authorized and directed to trace the proceeds of said sale or exchange and to use said proceeds, whether in the form of money or of any other investment, to comprise a part of the trust created under this Item.

- (b) The Trustees shall pay the net income from said property from the time of my death in annual or more frequent installments to my son, ALVIN W. LEVY, until his death.
- (c) The Trustees shall also be authorized to encroach on the principal of this trust in such amounts as they may deem necessary in their judgment to provide for the support in reasonable comfort of any of my descendants, taking into account any other means of support any of them may have to the knowledge of the Trustees.
- (d) My said son, ALVIN W. LEVY, shall have the power at any time and from time to time by instrument in writing signed by him, and delivered to the Trustees, to direct the Trustees to turn over any part of the property in this trust to or among such of my descendants or spouses of such descendants, and in such

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manner, in trust or otherwise, as my said son may in such instrument direct or appoint, provided that my said son shall have no power to appoint the property to himself, to his estate, to his creditors or to the creditors of his estate.

- (e) On the death of my said son, ALVIN W. LEVY, the property then remaining in this trust shall be distributed per stirpes among the descendants of my son, LOUIS K. LEVY, then living.
- (f) If at any time before the final distribution of this trust, all of the beneficiaries herein named or described should die and there should be no such beneficiary to take the property or the income therefrom, then the property remaining in this trust shall be distributed among the persons who would have been entitled thereto under the laws of descent and distribution of the State of Mississippi if I had died intestate at that time.

ITEM FIVE

- (a) I give, devise, and bequeath to the Trustees named above as Trustees so much of my property, as selected by my Executor, as will yield, based on yield at the time of my death, an annual income of \$3,000.00.
- (b) The Trustees shall pay the income from said property from the time of my death in annual or more frequent installments to my son, LOUIS K. LEVY, until his death.
- (c) The Trustee shall also be authorized to encroach on the principal of this trust in such amounts as they may deem necessary in their judgment to provide for the support in reasonable comfort of any of my descendants, taking into account any other means of support any of them may have to the knowledge of the Trustees.
- (d) My said son, LOUIS K. LEVY, shall have the power at any time and from time to time by instrument in writing signed by

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him and delivered to the Trustees, to direct the Trustees to turn over any part of the property in this trust to or among such of my descendants or spouses of such descendants, and in such manner, in trust or otherwise, as my said son may in such instrument direct or appoint, provided that my said son shall have no power to appoint the property to himself, to his estate, to his creditors or to the creditors of his estate.

- (e) On the death of my said son, LOUIS K. LEVY, the property then remaining in this trust shall be distributed per stirpes among the descendants of my son, LOUIS K. LEVY, then living.
- (f) If at any time before the final distribution of this trust, all of the beneficiaries herein named or described should die and there should be no such beneficiary to take the property or the income therefrom, then the property remaining in this trust shall be distributed among the persons who would have been entitled thereto under the laws of descent and distribution of the State of Mississippi if I had died intestate at that time.

ITEM SIX

(a) All of the rest, residue and remainder of my property of every kind and description, and wherever located, including any lapsed or void legacy or devise, I give, devise and bequeath per stirpes among the descendants of my son, LOUIS K. LEVY, who survive me. If there be no such descendants of my son, LOUIS K. LEVY, who survive me, then this property shall be distributed per stirpes among my descendants who survive me. If there be no descendants of mine who survive me, then this property shall be distributed among the persons who would have been entitled thereto under the laws of descent and distribution of the State of Mississippi if I had died intestate.

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ITEM SEVEN

All of the bank accounts, savings accounts, building and loan accounts, and other similar property I may own at the time of my death jointly in the name of myself and/or any other person which are by their terms payable to such other person at the date of my death shall be the sole property of such other person and my Executor shall make no claim against such person on account thereof.

ITEM EIGHT

My Executor shall make no claim against any person receiving the proceeds of any insurance policy or any money or property transferred by me during my lifetime for any part of the estate taxes assessed against my estate because of such insurance proceeds or such money or property; but shall make claim, if and to the extent permitted by law, for any such estate taxes assessed against my estate because of any power of appointment which I may have.

ITEM NINE

(a) In the management, care and disposition of my estate and of every trust I confer upon the Executor of this Will and the Trustee of every trust created by this Will, and the successors in office, the power to do all things and execute such instruments as may be deemed necessary or proper, including the following powers, all of which may be exercised without order of or report to any court.

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- (1) To sell, exchange, or otherwise dispose of any property at any time held or acquired under this Will, at public or private sale, for cash or on terms, without advertisement, including the right to lease for any term notwithstanding the period of the trust, and to grant options to buy for any period including a period beyond the duration of the trust;
- (2) To invest all money in such stocks, bonds, securities, investment company or trust shares, mortgages, notes, choses in action, real estate, improvements thereon, and other property as such Executor or Trustee may deem best without regard to any law now or hereafter in force limiting investments of fiduciaries;
- (3) To retain for investment any property or choses in action owned by me at the time of my death, including any stock in such corporate Executor or Trustee;
- (4) To vote in person or by proxy any corporate stock or other security and to agree to or take any other action in regard to any reorganization, merger, consolidation, liquidation, bankruptcy or other procedure or proceeding affecting any stock, bond, note or other property;
- (5) To use real estate brokers, accountants and other agents, if such employment be deemed necessary and to pay reasonable compensation for their services;
- (6) To compromise, settle and/or adjust any claim or demand by or against said estate or trust and

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to agree to any rescission or modification of any contract or agreement affecting such estate or trust;

- (7) To renew any indebtedness, as well as to borrow money, and to secure the same by mortgaging, pledging and/or conveying any property of such estate or trust, including the power to borrow from such Executor or Trustee at a reasonable rate of interest;
- (8) To retain and carry on any business in which I may own an interst at the time of my death, to acquire additional interest in any such business, to agree to the liquidation in kind of any corporation in which my estate or trust may have any interest and to carry on the business thereof, to join with other owners in adopting any form of management for any business or property in which my estate or trust may have an interest, to become or remain a partner, general or limited, in regard to any such business or property, to incorporate any such business or property and hold the stock or other securities an investment, and to employ agents and confer on them authority to manage and operate such business, property or corporation, without liability for the acts of any such agent or for any loss, liability, or indebtedness of such business if the management is selected or retained with reasonable care;
- (9) To register any stock, bond or other security in the name of a nominee, without the addition

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of words indicating that such security is held in a fiduciary capacity; but accurate records shall be maintained showing that such security is a trust asset and the Executor or Trustee shall be responsible for the acts of such nominee.

- (b) Whenever the Executor or Trustee is directed to pay any money to or to use any money for the benefit of or to deliver any property to any minor, the Executor or Trustee shall not require the appointment of a guardian, but shall be authorized to pay or deliver the same over to the person having custody of such minor, to pay or deliver the same to such minor without the intervention of a guardian, to pay or deliver the same to a legal guardian of such minor if one has already been appointed, or to use the same for the benefit of such minor.
- (c) Whenever the Executor or Trustee is directed to distribute any money or property in fee simple to a person who is then a minor, my Trustee shall be authorized to hold the share of such minor in trust for such minor until he or she becomes eighteen (18) years of age, and in the meantime shall use such part of the income and/or corpus of the share of such minor as such Trustee may deem necessary to provide for the proper support and education of such minor.
- (d) Whenever the Trustee is authorized or directed to make payment to a beneficiary, the Executor may, during the period of administration, make such payment directly to the beneficiary.

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- (e) No Executor or Trustee shall be required to file any inventory or appraisal or any annual or other returns or reports to any court or to give bond, but shall furnish a statement of receipts and disbursements at least annually to each person then entitled to income from my estate or any trust.
- (f) In the distribution of my estate and the division into separate trusts and shares, the Executor and Trustee shall be authorized to make the division in money or in kind or in both, and the division made and the values established by my Executor or Trustee shall be binding and conclusive on all persons taking hereunder. My Executor or Trustee may in making such division allot undivided interests in the same property to several trusts or shares.
- (g) My Executor or Trustee shall have discretion to determine whether items should be charged or credited to income or principal as the Executor or Trustee in his discretion may deem equitable and fair under all the circumstances, including the power to amortize or fail to amortize any part or all of any premium or discount, to treat any part or all of the profit resulting from the maturity or sale of any asset, whether purchased at a premium or at a discount, as income or principal or apportion the same between income and principal, to apportion the sales price of any asset between income and principal, to treat any dividend or other distribution on any investment as income or principal or apportion the same between income and principal, to charge any expense

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against income or principal or apportion the same, and to provide or fail to provide a reasonable reserve against depreciation or absolescence, all as the Executor or Trustee may reasonably deem equitable and just under all the circumstances.

- (h) The income on the part of my estate used to pay debts, taxes, expenses, general legacies and other such corpus changes, shall go to the income beneficiaries of the residue of my estate and shall not be added to the principal thereof.
- (i) My Executor or Trustee shall be authorized to make any election permitted by any tax law, if in the opinion of the Executor or Trustee such election if for the combined best interest of my estate and the beneficiaries thereof, and shall be authorized to make, or fail to make, such adjustment between the parties or the several bequests or accounts as such Executor or Trustee may deem equitable and just under all the circumstances.
- (j) My Executor and Trustee of any trust created by this Will shall be authorized to sell any property or to purchase any property from any other trust created by this Will or created by me during life, or from the estate of my spouse or from any trust created by my spouse by will or during life, at the fair market value thereof as determined by the Executor or Trustee, even though the same person or corporation may be acting as Trustee of any of such other trusts or as Executor of my spouse's estate and as my Executor or Trustee of the trusts hereunder.
