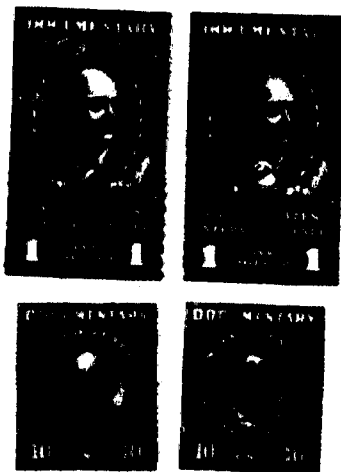


WARRANTY DEED
