Orleans, Louisiana, a niece of my late husband.

I do this because neither the said Simon H. Shiff nor Lillian  
Shiff Stein, over a long period of time, has made any effort to  
contact me in any way whatsoever, or to demonstrate in any manner  
any love, interest, affection or concern for me, and I do therefore  
deliberately and purposely eliminate them as beneficiaries under my  
Last Will and Testament.

All other terms and provisions of my Last Will and Testament  
dated June 2, 1976, shall remain unaltered and shall remain in full  
force and effect.

This matter this date coming on for hearing upon the duly sworn and verified Petition of Clifford Tillman, M. D., and the Court having duly considered all of the evidence offered in support of said Petition, does now affirmatively find and adjudicate as follows:

(1)

Clifford Tillman, M. D., is a bona fide adult resident citizen of Natchez, Adams County, Mississippi, and is the nephew of Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn.

(2)

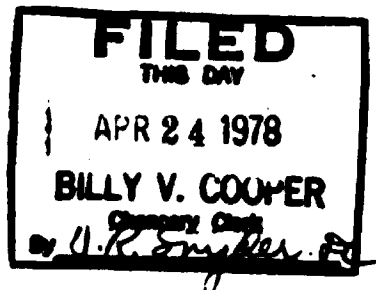
The said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn departed this life in Natchez, Adams County, Mississippi, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1978, at which time and for many years prior thereto she had and maintained her fixed place of residence in Natchez, Adams County, Mississippi.

The Court finds that at the time and date of the death of the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn, she was a widow, being the widow of the late Marx Kahn, deceased, and that the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn had been married but one time and then to Marx Kahn, and that no children were born of this marriage.

The Court further finds from the evidence that the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn did not in her lifetime adopt any person or persons.

The said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn left an instrument of writing entitled "Last Will and Testament of Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn", which is dated the 2nd day of June, 1976, and which said instrument is wholly testamentary in nature.

The Court finds from the evidence that said instrument of writing was signed, published and declared by the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn on the 2nd day of June, 1976, as and for her Last Will and Testament, in the presence of Lillye Mae Adams, Emily W. The Court further finds that under the terms and provisions of said Last Will and Testament the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn did

name and appoint the Petitioner, Clifford Tillman, M. D., to serve as Executor of her Last Will and Testament, and she directed that no bond or other security be required of him in the performance of his duties as Executor of her Last Will and Testament and Estate. The Court further finds that the said Clifford Tillman, M. D., is qualified to serve as such Executor and is willing to undertake the trusts thereby imposed upon him, and the Court further finds that said decedent did by the express terms and provisions of said instrument of writing waive any requirement of bond for the Petitioner to serve under as Executor of her estate.

The Court further finds that the said decedent, Aleyne Ascher Kahn, departed this life with an estate consisting of personalty and realty within the jurisdiction of this Court, and that it is necessary and advisable for an administration to be had and conducted upon her estate.

The Court further finds that the said Aleyne Ascher Kahn left an instrument of writing entitled, "Codicil to Last Will and Testament of Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn", and which said instrument of writing is testamentary in nature and is the first and only Codicil to the Last Will and Testament of Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn.

The Court finds and adjudicates that said instrument of writing entitled "Codicil to Last Will and Testament of Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn" is dated the 28th day of March, 1977, and was on said date signed, published and declared by the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn, as and for a Codicil to her Last Will and Testament, and that said instrument was then and there signed by Lillye Mae Adams, Emily W. Rosenthal and G. Stuart Handy, as subscribing witnesses, who, at the special instance and request of the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn,

and in her presence and sight, as well as in the presence and sight of each other, did sign and subscribe their names thereto as attesting witnesses.

At the time of the making and execution of said instrument of writing entitled "Codicil to Last Will and Testament of Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn", which is dated the 28th day of March, 1977, the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn was a bona fide resident citizen of Natchez, Adams County, Mississippi, over the age of twenty-one years, and had and maintained her fixed place of residence in Natchez, Adams County, Mississippi, where she had maintained her residence for many years prior to her death. On said date of the 28th day of March, 1977, the said Aleyne Ascher Kahn was of sound, disposing mind and memory, and entitled to make and execute a Last Will and Testament and/or Codicil thereto.

The Court finds that said instrument of writing entitled "Codicil to Last Will and Testament of Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn" should be admitted to probate and of record amongst the Will Records of Adams County, Mississippi, as and for a Codicil to her Last Will and Testament, said Last Will and Testament being dated the 2nd day of June, 1976, and which said Codicil to said Last Will and Testament is wholly testamentary in nature, and should be admitted to probate as a true Codicil to said decedent's Last Will and Testament.

IT IS NOW, THEREFORE, THIS DAY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said instrument of writing entitled "Last Will and Testament of Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn", which is dated the 2nd day of June, 1976, and which said instrument of writing was witnessed by Lillie Mae Adams, Emily W. Rosenthal, Thomas H. Gandy, M. D. and G. Stuart Handy, be and the same is hereby declared to be the true Last Will and Testament of Aleyne Ascher Kahn, and is hereby ordered to be admitted to

probate and of record amongst the Will Records of Adams County, Mississippi, as and for the true Last Will and Testament of the said Mrs. Aleyne Ascher Kahn, deceased.

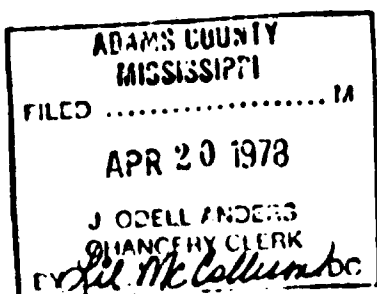

D., in the performance of his duties as Executor, said bond having been expressly waived by the terms and provisions of the Last Will and Testament of said decedent.
