BE IT REMEMBERED that the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Madison County, Mississippi was duly convened, held and conducted on the 22nd day of August, 2002, at the Madison County Chancery/Administrative Building in Canton, Mississippi, as follows, to-wit:

In the Matter of Authorization of the Purchase of Sprayers and Chemicals in Response to the State of Emergency

WHEREAS, Mr. Bill Weisenberger, with the Emergency Management Office, appeared before the Board of Supervisors and requested approval to purchase two more London Fog Sprayers and certain chemicals and that copies of the invoices regarding said purchases are found in the miscellaneous file to these minutes.
