NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS, TO WIT:

1. That the following described tract of real property be, and the same is hereby rezoned from its present SU-1 Special Use District Classification to A-1 Agricultural Use District Classification, to-wit:

The east half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 10 North, Range 5 East, less 10 acres off the north end, containing 70 acres, more or less.
