Quick Notes: Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, July 15, 2019.

- For Lake Caroline Boulevard, \$35,000 was approved to finish the project.
- For Flora, a contract was signed to address the Grisham Drainage Project, which is important because once completed, school buses will be able to safely navigate a more efficient route.
- The Board took action to begin the process of declaring the value of two parcels in preparation of Reunion 3.
- Members of the Board heard from a representative of Census 2020 about the importance of working with the County, towns and cities to ensure every citizen is counted. A correct Census count is essential because it is a part of some formulas that impact federal money coming to the County and to our representation in Washington, DC. The Board is going to work with Census 2020 to ensure a complete count.
- Due to an estimated 6-7%/year growth in Gluckstadt, the Board approved the construction of right in/right out lane for Church Road Bypass.
- The County will begin advertising for a new irrigation system for the grounds of the old courthouse.
