Quick Notes: Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, August 19, 2019

- It was approved that County forces will assist the Canton School District with site work to improve the yard at the Canton School Bus Barn.
- The board approved a proposal to appraise property at the intersection of Livingston Vernon and Virlilia Roads for the potential construction of a fire station in the Kearney Park Fire District.
- Brenda Fuselier was reappointed to serve on the South Madison County Fire Protection District.
- Paul Tankersly was appointed to the Nursing Home Board.
- Percy Campbell was reappointed to serve on the CMPDD Aging Advisory Committee.
- Penny Davis was reappointed to serve on the library board.
- The board finalized a contract with MSEG, which will continue work on the Reunion 2 project (initial design and layout, which is about 40 percent of project).
- Board members also agreed to offer an invitation to Madison, Ridgeland, Flora, and Canton to participate in a Household Hazardous Waste Disposal event.
- Sheriff Randy Tucker, as a follow up to the last board meeting, presented the board with prices on building a new facility to hold juveniles. He also provided them with pricing from other counties. The facility will cost about \$5 million to build. Madison County is currently using facilities in other counties who have more than tripled their price.
- Sheriff Randy Tucker also spoke with the board about hiring a new food service company to provide three meals a day. This move will save approximately \$50,000 per year.
