Quick Notes from the Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, 9/30/19

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors enacted a burn ban last night, and it was approved by the Forestry Commission this morning. The ban will be in effect for the next 30 days and will be reevaluated at the end of the 30-day period. Burn bans make it unlawful for campfires, bonfires, fire pits, fire rings, burn barrels, debris burning, and field burning anything with an open flame that produces an ember. The wind can carry floating embers away from the original fire and start a spot fire up to one-half mile away from the burning area.
- The Board approved approximately \$103,000 in fire service contract payments to Fire Districts.
- The Board approved two Right of Way Acquisitions totaling \$140,739 for Reunion 3.

This is the final Board of Supervisors meeting for the fiscal year.
