

Quick Notes from the Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, November 18, 2019

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors (the Board) authorized negotiations for the purchase of two acres of land for the Kearney Park Fire District.
- The Board approved a private drive to be named Cox Lane for emergency response purposes.
- The Board awarded a bid to Trustmark for short term borrowing at 1.99 percent interest.
- The Board reviewed Central Mississippi Planning District's proposed 25-year plan for transportation and other goals. Afterwards, the Board approved amendments to Zoning Maps and the Land use Plan.
- The Board approved the de-annexation of the area of South Madison Fire Protection District that was also within the City of Canton's incorporated area.
