Quick Notes: The Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, February 18, 2020

• The Madison County Board of Supervisors (the Board) approved the job description for the new Drainage and Crew Chief and the transfer of some equipment from the Road Department and personnel to help accomplish the mission of this new position. The job description is a follows:

Supervises and participates in the activities of crew members and leaders involving the maintenance of county gravel roads and bridges, installation of culverts and drainage associated with all county roads.

- The Board hired Na'son White as Comptroller for Madison County.
- The Board acknowledged the outstanding work being done by the volunteer fire department in Kearney Park and the new fire rating they just received which could lower fire insurance costs for residents.
- \$280,000 was approved by the Board for the State-Aid Engineer to overlay parts of Rice Road, from Old Canton Road to the Natchez Trace.
- \$840,000 was approved by the Board for the State-Aid Engineer to overlay parts of Livingston Vernon Road, from Highway 49 to Parkinson Road.
- \$1.25mm was approved by the Board for the State-Aid Engineer to overlay parts of Robinson Road, from Sharon Road to Pat Luckett Road.
- \$560,000 was approved by the Board for the State-Aid Engineer to treat parts of Pat Luckett Road.
- The Board acknowledged an Emergency Declaration for Madison County to apply for funds to correct damage caused by the recent flooding.
- The Board approved the purchase of a paving machine.
