Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, November 2, 2020: Quick Notes

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors (the Board) received an update on three major road projects:
 - 1) <u>Bozeman Road Improvements:</u> This \$24 million project will include street lighting, bike trails, intersection improvements and much more. Purchase of right-of-way is on schedule with construction expected to begin by early 2022.
 - 2) Reunion Crossing Parkway: This \$25 million project will include a bridge across I-55 and completing the link between Bozeman Road and Galleria Parkway. Purchase of right-of-way is on schedule with construction expected to begin in the summer of 2021.
 - 3) Reunion Phase III: This \$10 million project includes two long bridges one over Canadian National railroad tracks and a second to span flood mitigation area east of Galleria Parkway. Right-of-way acquisition is almost complete. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of 2021.
 - Initially signalization of the Highway 51 and Green Oak intersection were included, but this project has been separated into a stand-alone project. This project will be completed by MDOT and has an expected complete date of late 2021.
- The Board acknowledged a courthouse study prepared by JH&H Architects, which provided alternatives for additional space for courts. The analysis was completed following months of consultation with Madison County Judges, the Madison County Administrator, and the architects. Supervisors took the plan under advisement.
- The Board voted to allow Joe McGee Construction Company to subcontract portions of the Robinson Road Overlay Project to Erocon, LLC, Atwood Fence Company, Lane Line, LLC, Mississippi Paving and Construction, and Engineering Plus.
- The Board voted to accept the site plan for Candlewood Suites to build a hotel in Dees Plaza.
- The Board voted to accept the site plan for Sullivan's Market to build a grocery store on Calhoun Station Parkway.
- The Board voted to accept the site plan for an addition to Camper Corral on Distribution Drive

- The Board acknowledged the Madison County Schools bus turn-around list.
- The Board approved participation in the 2021 Emergency Medical Services Operating Fund Grant.
- The Board approved Just Compensation for right-of-way purchases associated with the Bozeman Road Improvement project.
