

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, December 21, 2020: Quick Notes

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors (the Board) heard from members of the Madison County Homeowners Association regarding their support for a Golf Cart Ordinance.

As a result of their request, the Board requested that the County Attorney and the Sheriff work together to craft a request for legislation to be filed by a member of the Madison County legislative delegation.

- The Board voted to authorize the Board President to execute an Engagement Letter with The Clearwater Group for monitoring and providing legislative services at the state level on behalf of Madison County.
- The Board voted to authorize the Board President to execute an Engagement Letter with Butler Snow for monitoring and providing legislative services at the federal level on behalf of Madison County.
- The Board approved a TIF development plan for Renaissance Phases III and IV, which does not include the Costco properties.
- The Board granted True Vine Christian Ministries tax exempt status for a building they recently purchased. They are already considered a tax-exempt entity by the Internal Revenue Service.
- The Board granted New Way Mississippi Nonprofit tax-exempt status.
- The Board approved refunding Taxable GO Bonds/series 2021A for a lower interest rate of 1.5 percent.
- The Board approved and awarded the construction contract to the lowest bidder for building a 1,000,000-gallon elevated water tank in preparation for Amazon to CB&I Storage Tank Solutions, LLC., for \$2,944,000.

The Board voted to declare 1.52 acres of property on the southwest corner of the Madison County Detention Center site as surplus property and then approved advertise for sale of the property.
