

The Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, February 22, 2022: Quick Notes

- The Board approved Trustmark National Bank's proposal for lease purchase financing of road maintenance equipment at 1.98 percent interest over 5 years.
- The County awarded the bid for solid waste collection and recycling services to Waste Management – the current vendor. There are no planned changes in pickup schedules.
- The Board approved an agreement with the City of Gluckstadt to repair potholes and to perform other simple repairs in Gluckstadt until September 30, 2023, in exchange for the city's share of road taxes. As a new city, Gluckstadt does not yet have the staff and equipment to repair roads in the city and the county has agreed to assist.
- The Board voted to hold a public hearing on March 21, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. in the boardroom to discuss the possible abandonment of Swamp Road.
- At the request of the Central Mississippi Planning Development District, the Board passed a resolution in support of passenger rail efforts in Central Mississippi.
- The Board approved the final plat for Glendale Farms, IA.
- The Board approved a temporary construction easement to work on a pipe that is causing water to back-up into Keating Circle.
- The Board recognized correspondence from the Central Mississippi Planning and Development District advising that Madison County will receive a \$2.4mm grant to widen Yandell Road from Westfalen Drive to Madison County Elementary School.
