- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, (the Board), approved the map regarding district lines for Justice Court Judges and Constables for consideration. Tommie Cardin, with Butler Snow Law Firm, provided the map to the Board for review.
- Waggoner Engineering provided the Board with proposals to consider for broadband in the Northern part of the County. The Board also named a committee to review the proposals (Darion Warren with Waggoner Engineering, County Administrator Shelton Vance, County Attorney Mike Espy and Supervisors Paul Griffin and Gerald Steen).
- The Board hired Stantec to perform CE&I services for Reunion Parkway, Phase 3. The Board also approved allowing the Engineering Division to begin contract negotiations.
- The Board approved striping on Cedar Hill Road from Highway 463 to Highway 22.
- The Board acknowledged agreements between the Madison County Republican Executive Committee and the Madison County Democratic Executive Committee and the Madison County Election Commission to perform specific duties for the June 7, 2022, primary election.
- The Board voted to approve a contract with Waste Management for garbage collection and recycling services.
- The Board accepted a fire truck for the Valley View Fire District.
