The Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting, May 2, 2022: Quick Notes

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, (the Board), recognized the inaugural class of the Madison County Executive Leadership Class.
- The Board voted to opt out of allowing a Medical Cannabis Dispensaries in the unincorporated areas of Madison County.
- The Board approved purchasing a single axle dump trump chassis from the lowest and best bidder, Tri State Truck Center, for \$113,716.
- The Board approved a resolution authorizing the Engineering Department to apply for funding to repair certain bridges on Yandell Road and North Old Canton Road.
- The Board approved the final plat of Katherine Lake I of Caroline. The development contains 18 lots on 7.16 acres.
- The Board approved the conditional use of property in Madison County to be used as an equestrian center.
- The Board approved the site plan for a spec building for the Madison County Economic Development Authority (MCEDA).
- The Board approved submitting a grant application to the United States Department of Justice to provide additional substance and mental health treatment services and to provide family counseling.
- The Board approved submitting a grant application to the United States Department of Justice that will assist with the supervision and treatment and other recovery support services that address opioid, stimulant, and other substance, or polysubstance use disorders.
- Supervisor Karl Banks appointed Teresa Kennedy, Chip Estes, and Tim Taylor to the NCRS Watershed Local Sponsor Committee.
