

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: March 4, 2024

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” passed the following motions regarding the Bozeman Road Project:
 - To readvertise for construction bids for Bozeman Road widening from Reunion Crossing to Highway 463, including a multiuse path from Highway 463 to Gluckstadt Rd, and improvements to two intersections.
 - To advertise for construction bids for improvements at the intersection of Bozeman Road and Gluckstadt Road.
 - To advertise for construction bids for widening Bozeman Road from Reunion Crossing to Highway 463.
 - To provide County Engineer Tim Bryan with the authority to start the process of purchasing right-of-way and moving utilities that have not already been purchased/moved for the Bozeman Road phase 2.
- The Board approved advertising for construction bids for softball fields at Sulphur Springs Park.
- Madison County acknowledged the award of \$600,000 through a Community Development Block Grant to help pay for sewer rehabilitation in the Kearney Park area. The \$800,000 project will be funded with \$200,000 of county American Rescue Plan Funds and \$600,000 of grant funds.
- The Board granted tax exemption status for a parcel owned by *Word of Life Christian Fellowship, Inc.*
- The Board approved the final plat of Wildoak, Phase 2. The development will have 22 lots on approximately 6.61 acres.
- The Board approved the placement of 2 speed humps on Luckett Lane.

The Madison County Board of Supervisors will meet next on March 18, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in the Administrative Building in Canton.
