

Madison County Board of Supervisors Meeting Quick Notes: November 3, 2025

- The Madison County Board of Supervisors, “the Board,” acknowledged a request for 10 percent of future opioid settlement funds for adult drug courts.
- The Board approved allowing the City of Ridgeland to use E-911 funds for the replacement of PA Systems.
- The Board approved allowing the City of Madison to use E-911 funds to replace radio equipment.
- The Board approved the final plat for South Hampton Garden Homes of Lake Caroline, Phase 2.
- The Board approved an agreement for Right of Way Acquisition services for the Livingston-Vernon Road/Cedar Hill Road Highway 22 Intersection Re-Alignment Project with McMaster & Associates, Inc. for a fee not to exceed \$101,009.50.
- The Board approved a preliminary plat for White Oak Farms, Phase I-Revised.
- The Board approved a preliminary plat for Madisonville, Phase 3.
- The Board approved purchasing 3.7 acres near Cobblestone to construct a building for the tax assessor and the tax collector.
- The Board accepted a donation of sod to be used at the Canton Historic Courthouse from the Canton Garden Club.
