**In the Matter of Granting Sheriff Trowbridge's
Request to Allow Personnel to be Hired Individually
for Security Purposes**

WHEREAS, Section 21-19-49(3) provides that the governing authority of any Board of Supervisors may allow off-duty law enforcement officers who are hired individually for security purposes by the School District or districts within that County to use County law enforcement uniforms and equipment during such off-duty employment; and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Toby Trowbridge did appear before the Board and request that his personnel to be allowed to be hired individually for security purposes by the School Districts within Madison County and to be allowed to use County law enforcement uniforms and equipment during such off-duty employment.

Following a discussion of this matter, Supervisor Karl Banks did move and Supervisor Paul Griffin did second a motion to grant the Sheriff's request to allow his personnel to be hired individually for security purposes by the School Districts within Madison County and be allowed to use the County law enforcement uniforms and equipment during such off-duty employment.
