#### REGULAR MEETING OF NOVEMBER 26, 2002 Recessed from regular meeting conducted on November 22, 2002

BE IT REMEMBERED that the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Madison County, Mississippi was duly convened, held and conducted on the 26th day of November, 2002, at the Madison County Chancery/Administrative Building in Canton, Mississippi, as follows, towit:

### In the Matter of Approval of Modification Agreement Between Madison County, Mississippi and Trustmark National Bank

WHEREAS, Madison County has previously borrowed the sum of \$2,000,000 from Trustmark National Bank; and

WHEREAS, both parties now desire to modify said original loan agreement to extend the maturity date until February 15, 2003 and that a copy of said proposed Modification Agreement is found in the miscellaneous file to these minutes.

"Bill" Banks moved and Supervisor Marc Sharpe seconded a motion to approve the Modification Agreement between Madison County and Trustmark National Bank, a copy of which is found in the miscellaneous file to these minutes and to further authorize the Board President to execute said agreement for and on behalf of Madison County.
