WHEREAS, Mr. Bill Weisenberger, with Emergency Management, appeared before the Board of Supervisors and requested authority to purchase chemicals for the County's use in eradicating mosquitos in connection with the State of Emergency caused by the West Nile Virus being present in Madison County.

Following discussion of this matter, Supervisor W.T. "Bill" Banks moved and Supervisor Marc Sharpe seconded a motion to authorize Mr. Weisenberger to purchase 120 Permonome RTU for the sum of \$4,140.00 to be used in connection with the State of Emergency declared by Madison County due to the outbreak of the West Nile Virus.
