Bell seeking a special exception for the placement of a mobile home in an R-2 District located at 120 Echols Street, Flora, Mississippi. Upon motion of Commissioner Hamilton and second of Commissioner Presley, with all present voting "aye" the Petition was recommended for approval with the condition that the permit be issued for Methel W. Bell only and that in the event she no longer uses the trailer the trailer will have to be removed. Further, upon the condition that the permit will be subject to a three year limitation.

There next came on for consideration the Petition of Robert A. Brown, Jr. seeking to rezone property from R-1-A Residential to C-2 Commercial located on Highway 51 at Yandell Road, being a 4.66 acre tract. Upon motion of Commissioner Presley and second of Commissioner Hamilton, with all present voting "aye", the Petition was recommended for approval.

There next came on for consideration the claim for attorney's fees of Don McGraw in the sum of \$366.00. Upon motion of Commissioner Warnock and second of Commissioner Hamilton, with all present voting "aye", the claim for attorney's fees was recommended for payment.
