WHEREAS, Mr. Doby did strongly urge the Board to rescind its Resolution of November 27, 2006 and instead adopt a Resolution calling on MDOT to accelerate its current plans to fourlane Highway 463, but that such four-laning cease at the proposed Reunion Parkway intersection, and

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Madison County Board of Supervisors desires to publicly announce its support for the widening to a four lane state highway <u>only</u> that portion of Mississippi Highway 463 commencing approximately at the intersection of said Highway with the current north entrance to Madison Central High School (to be named Park Place Boulevard) to a terminal point at the intersection of said Highway 463 with the new Reunion Parkway currently under construction, and to limit said four-laning accordingly, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MADISON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THAT:

1. The Mississippi Department of Transportation should immediately commence whatever environmental study it feels necessary with regard to the four-laning of State Highway 463 from the intersection of said Highway with the current north entrance to Madison Central High School (to be named Park Place Boulevard) to a terminal point at the intersection of said Highway 463 and the new Reunion Parkway currently under construction only.

2. The Mississippi Department of Transportation should immediately accelerate the aforesaid four-laning project from its current commencement date in 2011.

3. The Clerk of this Board forward this Resolution to the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Jackson metropolitan area, representatives of the Mississippi Department of Transportation, including Central District Transportation Commissioner Dick Hall and Chief Engineer Harry Lee James and any other governmental or private body having any interest in or potential impact on the highway project described above and also advise said persons and entities of the rescission of the previously adopted Resolution.

In re: Consideration of Tax Increment Financing Plan – Canton West Improvement Project

THERE CAME on for consideration by the Board of Supervisors (the "Governing Body") of Madison County (the "County"), the matter of the Tax Increment Financing Plan, Canton West Improvement Project, Madison County, Mississippi, December 2006, and a resolution regarding such Tax Increment Financing Plan. After a full consideration of the matter, Supervisor Karl M. Banks offered and moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, DETERMINING THE NECESSITY FOR AND INVOKING THE AUTHORITY GRANTED TO COUNTIES BY THE LEGISLATURE WITH RESPECT TO TAX INCREMENT FINANCING AS SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 45 OF TITLE 21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, AS AMENDED, DETERMINING THAT THE CANTON WEST IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, IS A PROJECT ELIGIBLE FOR TAX INCREMENT FINANCING UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE, THAT A PUBLIC HEARING BE CONDUCTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE TAX INCREMENT FINANCING PLAN, AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. WHEREAS, the Mississippi "Tax Increment Financing Act", Title 21, Chapter 45, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended (the "Act"), authorizes municipalities and counties in the State of Mississippi to undertake and carry out redevelopment projects as defined therein with the use of Tax Increment Financing as set forth in detail in the Act;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County has heretofore approved the Tax Increment Financing Redevelopment Plan of 2004, Madison County, Mississippi, and has conducted a public hearing on such Redevelopment Plan as required by law, which Plan constitutes a qualified plan under the Act;

WHEREAS, this Governing Body has been presented with a Tax Increment Financing Plan entitled Tax Increment Financing Plan, Canton West Improvement Project, Madison County, Mississippi, December 2006, hereinafter referred to as the TIF Plan, the purpose of which is to provide a financing mechanism to construct various infrastructure improvements described in the TIF Plan;

WHEREAS, this Governing Body has heretofore identified various parts of the County in need of development and redevelopment and does hereby find that the Canton West Improvement Project, is of major economic significance to and within the County and qualifies as a project eligible for Tax Increment Financing as set forth in the Redevelopment Plan, and participation on the part of the County is necessary and would be in the public interest and in the best interests of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County proposes to issue Tax Increment Financing Revenue Bonds or Notes, jointly with the City of Canton (the "City"), in one or more series, in an amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000), which will be secured solely by a pledge of the increased ad valorem taxes on real property and sales tax rebates generated by construction and development in the TIF District, which funds will be used to pay the cost of constructing various infrastructure improvements including, but not limited to, installation and/or relocation of utilities such as water, sanitary sewer, natural gas lines, electricity, construction of drainage improvements, construction of roadways with curb and gutter, asphalt overlay, installation of traffic signalization and signage, landscaping of rights-of way, irrigation, acquisition of rights of way, related engineering fees, attorney's fees, TIF Plan preparation fees, capitalized interest, and other related soft costs; and

WHEREAS, the County may exercise its authority as authorized by section 21-45-3 of the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the County, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the Governing Body of the County does hereby declare its intention to issue Tax Increment Financing Revenue Bonds or Notes, jointly with the City, in one or more series, in an amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) (the "Bonds") for the purpose of providing funds necessary to pay for the construction of various infrastructure improvements in connection with the construction of the Project, including, but not limited to, installation and/or relocation of utilities such as water, sanitary sewer, natural gas lines, electricity, construction of drainage improvements, construction of roadways with curb and gutter, asphalt overlay, installation of traffic signalization and signage, landscaping of rights-of way, irrigation, acquisition of rights of way, related engineering fees, attorney's fees, TIF Plan preparation fees, capitalized interest, and other related soft costs.

SECTION TWO: When and if issued, the Bonds shall be secured solely by a pledge of the incremental increase in ad valorem tax revenues on real property generated by construction and development in the TIF District, and shall not be secured by the full faith, credit, and taxing power of the County or create any other pecuniary liability on the part of the County other than the pledge of the incremental increase in ad valorem taxes heretofore set forth.

SECTION THREE: That a public hearing shall be held with respect to the TIF Plan in the regular meeting place of this Governing Body at 9:00 A.M., on the 18th day of December 2006.

SECTION FOUR: That the Clerk is hereby directed to publish the attached notice in The Madison County Herald one (1) time not less than ten (10) days nor more than twenty (20) days prior to the date set forth in section three hereof.
