MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

REGULAR MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2004 Recessed from regular meeting conducted on September 24, 2004

BE IT REMEMBERED that the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Madison County, Mississippi was duly convened, held and conducted on September 30, 2004, at the Madison County Chancery/Administrative Building in Canton, Mississippi, as follows, to-wit:

The President announced that the members of the Board present constituted a quorum and declared the meeting duly convened. Supervisor Andy Taggart opened the meeting with a prayer and Board Secretary Cynthia Parker led the members and the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

In the Matter of Amending the Budget for the Current Fiscal Year

WHEREAS, County Comptroller Mark Houston appeared before the Board of Supervisors and presented a budget update together with certain budget amendments for FY 2004 and requested that the Board of Supervisors amend the current fiscal year budget and accept the amended budget as presented, and

WHEREAS, a printout reflecting amended budget receipts and amended budget expenditures may be found in the Miscellaneous Appendix to these Minutes,

WHEREAS, Mr. Taggart did point out that (1) the Board inherited a <u>deficit</u> budget that included the use of beginning cash balances, but that (2) the Board was ending the year with a year end budget which, with the addition of release funds from the reappraisal trust fund to the general fund, reflected a <u>surplus</u> and <u>did not</u> include the use of beginning cash balances, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Taggart did observe that the amended budget as presented by the Comptroller represented a significantly improved financial position for the county and thanked the county's professional leadership for the achievement of this objective,

Following discussion of this matter, Mr. Andy Taggart did offer and Mr. Paul Griffin did second a motion to amend the current fiscal year budget to include actual expenditures incurred as of September 30, 2003. The vote on the matter being as follows:
