#### In re: Approval of Final Plat of Kingston Place Part II B

WHEREAS, Mr. Granberry pointed out that the Board had, on one other occasion, approved a subdivision without completed streets and infrastructure, and informed the Board that the developer of this subdivision was requesting the same consideration, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Granberry did also report to the Board that the streets were private use,
