The Clerk reported that pursuant to a resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Madison, Mississippi (the "Governing Body" of the "County") calling for a public hearing to be held on December 3rd, 2007 at 9:00 a.m., with respect to the petition for the creation of the Lost Rabbit Public Improvement District (the "Petition"), a copy of which is attached hereto as EXHIBIT A, he did cause a notice of the public hearing to be published in the Madison County Herald, a newspaper having a general circulation in the County and in which the County is authorized to publish legal notices, on November 8, November 15, November 22, and November 29, 2007, as evidenced by the proof of publication on file in the office of the Clerk. On Monday, December 3rd, 2007, the public hearing was duly convened. At that time, all present were given an opportunity to present oral and/or written comment on the Petition. After a full consideration and discussion of the matter, Supervisor Douglas L. Jones offered and moved the closure of the public hearing thereon and the adoption of the following resolution, on condition that all quantities of materials associated with the construction of public improvements by said District be submitted to the County Engineer for his approval and contingent upon his review of the legal description of the geographical boundaries of the District, to-wit:

WHEREAS, under the power and authority granted by the laws of the State of Mississippi, and particularly Sections 19-31-1 et seq. of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended (the "Act"), the Governing Body of the County on November 5th, 2007, did adopt a certain resolution entitled:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MADISON, MISSISSIPPI, ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE PETITION FOR THE CREATION OF LOST RABBIT PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (THE "PETITION"), AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE PETITION BE HELD PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ACT, CODIFIED AT SECTIONS 19-31-1, ET SEQ., OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE ANNOTATED (1972, AS AMENDED) (THE "ACT"); AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, as directed by the aforesaid resolution and as required by the Act, a notice of public hearing was published in the newspaper having general circulation in the County at least once a week for four successive weeks immediately prior to the date set for the hearing, as evidenced by the Publisher's Proof of Publication attached hereto as EXHIBIT B, the same having heretofore been presented by the Governing Body and filed with the Clerk; and

WHEREAS, said notice of public hearing described the time and place for the hearing, and gave a description of the area to be included in the proposed public improvement district; and

WHEREAS, at 9:00 a.m. on December 3rd, 2007, the public hearing was held and all in attendance were given the opportunity to state or present their views on the proposed establishment of Lost Rabbit Public Improvement District (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County has considered the record of the public hearing and other relevant factors in making its determination to grant or deny the Petition as required by the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Petition contains the written consent to the establishment of the District by all the landowners within the proposed boundaries of the District;

WHEREAS, the creation of the District will constitute a timely, efficient, effective, responsive and economical method of delivering public improvements and facilities in the area comprising the District; and

WHEREAS, the District will help with the County's planning, management and financing needs for the delivery of public improvements and facilities to and within the District without overburdening the County and its taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has decided to take said matter under advisement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Governing Body did conduct a public hearing pursuant to the notice contained in EXHIBIT B.

SECTION 2. That the Governing Body has decided to take said matter under advisement.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately and all resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

WHEREAS, the District will constitute an efficient, effective and economical method of delivering public improvements and facilities in the area described in EXHIBIT A (Exhibit C to these Minutes); and

WHEREAS, the District will help with the County's planning, management and financing needs for the delivery of public improvements and facilities to and within the District without overburdening the County and its taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, on December 3rd, 2007, the Governing Body of the County held a public hearing on the Petition in accordance with the requirements and procedures of the Act and did adopt a resolution entitled:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MADISON, MISSISSIPPI ACKNOWLEDGING THAT A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE PETITION TO ESTABLISH LOST RABBIT PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT WAS HELD AND FURTHER ACTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WAS TAKEN UNDER ADVISEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County has considered the record of the public hearing and other relevant factors pursuant to the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby established a public improvement district within the County and such district shall be designated as "Lost Rabbit Public Improvement District."

SECTION 2. That Lost Rabbit Public Improvement District shall include that particular real property described in EXHIBIT A (Exhibit C to these Minutes), attached hereto and made a part hereof, and the District shall exercise the powers described and authorized in the Act.

SECTION 3. The five (5) persons designated to serve as the initial members of the Board of Directors of the District are Walter Walford, Laura Walford, Robbie Wilbur, Bennett Chotard, who is a resident of the area immediately adjacent to the District as required by the Act, and Harris Williams.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately and all ordinances and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.
