WHEREAS, Mr. Caughman did recommend the Board adopt the proposal by Red River Service Corporation submitted in response to a request for proposals, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Caughman did introduce Mr. David Cooper and Mr. Jim Smith with Red River Service Corporation, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cooper did address the Board at length and answered numerous questions and concerns about the proposed contract, providing details as to garbage pickup requirements, management practices, location of facilities, acceptance of complaints, and handling of problems,

Following lengthy discussion, deliberation and debate, Mr. Andy Taggart did move and Mr. Karl M. Banks did second a motion to authorize the County Administrator to enter into a final contract with Red River Service Corporation to provide solid waste and garbage pickup service for the county, consistent with the Synopsis and Analysis of Proposal (Exhibit A) as adjusted by the Solid Waste Analysis dated August 5, 2004 (Exhibit B) and subject to review by and modification of said contract by the Board Attorney.
