BE IT REMEMBERED that the Special Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Madison County, Mississippi was duly convened, held and conducted on August 24, 2010, in the Board Room on the first floor of the Chancery/Administrative Building, 125 West North Street, Canton, Mississippi, as follows, to-wit:

The President announced that the members of the Board present constituted a quorum and declared the meeting duly convened.

As required by statue, that certain Notice of the instant meeting, which was posted at the Courthouse door (at the entrance to the Chancery and Administrative Building, 125 W. North Street, Canton, Mississippi) for at least five (5) days, was and is hereby entered on the Minutes hereof as Exhibit A.

In re: Awarding of Bid for Excavator (Trackhoe)

WHEREAS, County Purchase Clerk Hardy Crunk appeared before the Board and presented the bids for the purchase of an excavator (trackhoe) which were opened and received on August 17, 2010 pursuant to a prior order of the Board, and

WHEREAS, said original bids, in there original envelopes may be found in the Miscellaneous Appendix to these Minutes, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Crunk called the Board's attention to certain irregularities with regard to the bid of the apparent low bidder, Lyle Equipment Company, and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of Mr. Crunk's memorandum dated August 22, 2010 containing the bid tabulations and his recommendations thereon, as well as a thorough discussion of the irregularities which the Board carefully reviewed, is attached hereto as Exhibit B, spread hereupon and incorporated herein by reference, and

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Following discussion, Mr. Paul Griffin did offer and Mr. D. I. Smith did second a motion to (1) find, for the reasons stated in Mr. Crunk's August 22, 2010 memorandum to the Board, that Lyle's "intended correct bid with trade in" for the Komatsu excavator is \$127,989, and correct Lyle's bid accordingly; (2) find, for the reasons stated in said memorandum, that Lyle's failure to include a copy of its full-machine three-year warranty is a bidding irregularity that (a) does not violate any mandatory statutory provisions, (b) does not in any way destroy the competitive character of the bidding process, (c) has no effect as to the amount of the bid, and (d) does not give Lyle an advantage or benefit over any other bidder; and, therefore, the Board waives said irregularity; (3) declare the county's Kobelco excavator (serial number YQ07U0302, county asset number 1064) surplus; and (4) in the name of financial prudence and in the best interest of the taxpayers of Madison County, find that Lyle's "corrected bid with trade in" in the amount of \$127,989 is the lowest and best bid, award said bid to Lyle in the amount reflected on the "corrected bid with trade in," \$127,989, and authorize the trade-in to Lyle of the county's Kobelco excavator previously declared surplus. The vote on the matter being as follows:

In re: Request for Refund to Stillhouse Creek, LLC

WHEREAS, County Administrator Brad Sellers appeared before the Board and requested the Board authorize a refund of \$51,000.00 to Mr. Blake Cress of Stillhouse Creek, LLC, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sellers reported to the Board that on April 19, 2010, Mr. Cress presented a check in the amount of \$51,000.00 to replace the letter of credit for Stillhouse Creek Subdivision, Phase 1, and said check was deposited in the general fund of the county by the Chancery Clerk as directed by the Board, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cress is requesting the Board refund said funds to him and he will present a letter of credit covering Stillhouse Creek, Phase 1 and Phase 2 for maintenance of streets, in place and instead of said cash funds, and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of said letter of credit is attached hereto as Exhibit C, spread hereupon and incorporated herein by reference, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sellers stated that the amount of said letter of credit was sufficient to cover the developer's remaining liability associated with Stillhouse Creek Phase 1 and 2,

Following discussion, Mr. Paul Griffin did offer and Mr. D. I. Smith did second a motion to (1) authorize the Chancery Clerk to issue a refund unto Stillhouse Creek, LLC in the amount of \$51,000.00 and (2) direct the Chancery Clerk to accept and retain the aforesaid letter of credit for Sillhouse Creek, Phase 1 and 2.
