BE IT REMEMBERED that the Special Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Madison County, Mississippi was duly convened, held and conducted on April 13, 2011, in the Board Room on the first floor of the Chancery/Administrative Building, 125 West North Street, Canton, Mississippi, as follows, to-wit:

The Vice President announced that the members of the Board present constituted a quorum and declared the meeting duly convened.

As required by statue, that certain Notice of the instant meeting, which was posted at the Courthouse door (at the entrance to the Chancery and Administrative Building, 125 W. North Street, Canton, Mississippi) for at least five (5) days, was and is hereby entered on the Minutes hereof as Exhibit A.

In re: Awarding of Bid for Portable Generators

WHEREAS, County Purchase Clerk Hardy Crunk appeared before the Board and presented the bids for the purchase of one or more portable generators which were opened and received on April 5, 2011, pursuant to a prior order of the Board, and

WHEREAS, said original bids, in there original envelopes may be found in the Miscellaneous Appendix to these Minutes, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Crunk called the Board's attention to certain irregularities with regard to several bids that are outlined in that memorandum dated April 8, 2011 containing the bid tabulations and his recommendations thereon, as well as a thorough discussion of the irregularities which the Board carefully reviewed, is attached hereto as Exhibit B, spread hereupon and incorporated herein by reference, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Crunk further reported that E911 Director Butch Hammack developed the specifications for the trailer mounted 140KW generators in conjunction with the city engineer and public works director of the Town of Flora and that anything larger than the 140KW would damage water well pump motors, and WHEREAS, Mr. Crunk did recommend that the Board award the bid to Taylor Power System's as the best and lowest bid in the amount of \$43,000.00 per trailer mounted portable 140KW generators,

Following discussion, Mr. Karl M. Banks did offer and Mr. D. I. Smith did second a motion to (1) reject the bid of \$33,536 submitted by The Generator Store, Monroe, LA, due to the fact that the company's bid does not meet the specifications by submitting its bid for a 150KW generator instead of the required 140KW generator; (2) reject the bid of \$39,614 submitted by Lighting Power, Coral Gables, Florida, due to the fact that the company's bid does not meet the specifications by submitting bid its for a permanent-mounted generator; (3) reject the bid of \$40,427 submitted by Cummin's Mid-South, LLC., Jackson, MS, due to the fact that the company's bid does not meet the specifications by submitting its bid for a 150KW generator instead of the required 140KW generator; (4) reject all bids for 350KW generators due to the fact that we will not be buying that size; and (5) accept the bid of Taylor Power System's, Richland, MS, in the amount of \$43,000 each for three trailer mounted portable140KW generators. The vote on the matter being as follows:
