There first came on for consideration the Minutes of the April 14, 2011 meeting. Upon motion by Commissioner Steere, seconded by Commissioner Brown, with all voting "aye", motion to approve the minutes passed.

There next came on for consideration the petition of Dalton and Patricia Crotwell for permission to rezone R-1 Residential and C-1 Commercial District to C-2 Commercial District. Zoning Administrator Sellers was not present due to a conflict, and, therefore, Scott Weeks presided in his absence. Scott Weeks introduced the petition to the Commission. The underlying reason discussed for the request for rezoning was due to the marketability of the property and intentions to move forward with the sale of the property. The petitioners stated that they intend to move due to traffic and maintenance concerns, and in connection with these plans, would desire the requested rezoning to facilitate in the sale of the property. Upon motion by Commissioner Steere, seconded by Commissioner Sligh, with all voting "aye", the petition was recommended for approval to the Board of Supervisors.


