

All requests for cancellation must be made in writing. They can be sent via e-mail to nacomeetings@naco. org (Subject line: Annual Meeting Cancellation); or via fax 866/741-5129.

- Requests received by June 24, 2016 will receive a full refund minus a \$75 administrative fee.
- Requests received after June 24, 2016 and before July 15, 2016 will receive a 50 percent refund.
- Requests received after July 15, 2016 will not be refunded.

If you cancel your registration prior to July 15, 2016, we will automatically cancel your hotel reservation. If you cancel after July 15, you must contact the hotel directly to cancel your hotel reservation. Please note that the hotel may have a separate penalty for late cancellations.

ATTIRE:

GETTING TO LONG BEACH:

It's easy getting to and around Long Beach. From airports, travel by car, limo, shuttle or the efficient Long Beach Yellow Cab. From downtown Long Beach, Los Angeles International (LAX) and John Wayne-Orange County (SNA) airports are less than 30 minutes away while the ultraconvenient, affordable Long Beach/ Daugherty Field Airport (LGB) is just seven minutes from the city center. Explore Long Beach on foot, bike or onboard the free downtown Passport shuttle. Downtown's First Street Station connects you to Los Angeles attractions and surrounding cities. During the Annual Conference you'll be able to explore the lively waterfront via AquaBus and AquaLink.
