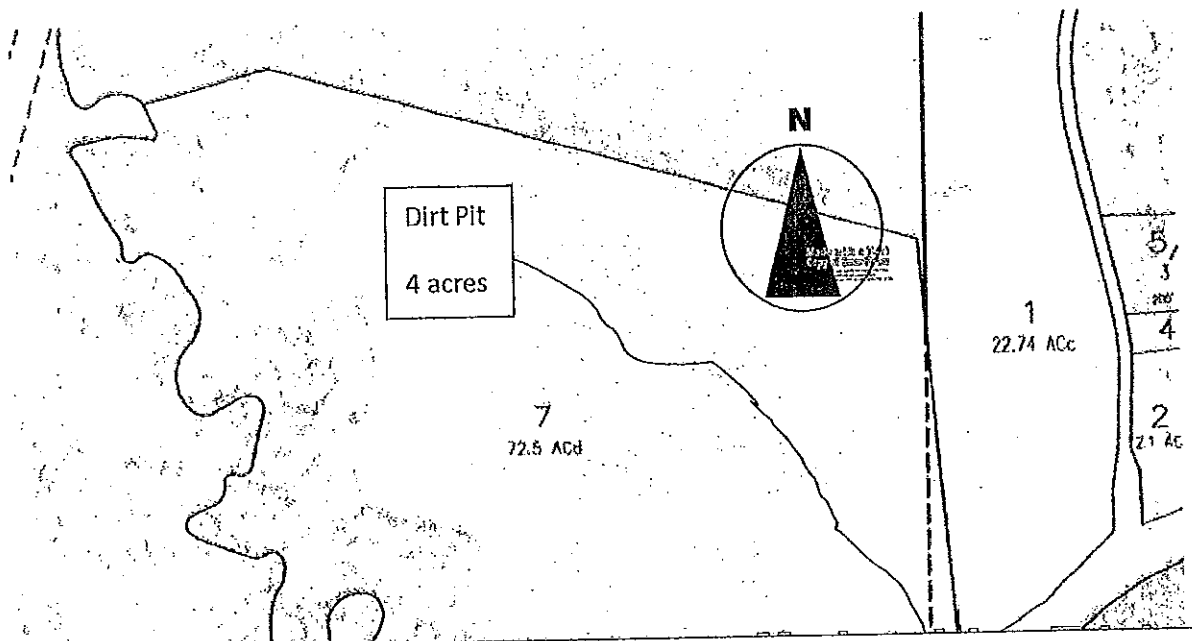
PIT LAYOUT
