

MADISON COUNTY
Redistricting Tasks and Cost Estimate
June, 2016

PHASE I

Initiate Redistricting Effort

- CMPDD will meet with Board and explain redistricting procedures
- Develop criteria (acceptable to Board and Department of Justice) to guide redistricting process
- Develop resolution establishing redistricting guidelines
- Determine which districts are most in need of changing

Citizen Participation

- CMPDD will explain Department of Justice requirements
- Provide public hearing notices
- CMPDD will assist in holding public hearings
- Record and document citizen participation to comply with Department of Justice (DOJ) regulations

Re-Draw Ward Boundaries

- Discuss possibilities of potential change with the Board
- Based on the County's needs, begin changing district lines on CMPDD's GIS computerized mapping system
- Develop a proposed plan to comply with the one-person, one-vote principle, Department of Justice and State regulations
- Present proposal to Board
- Hold public hearing
- Assist the County with adoption of the plan in accordance with all applicable regulations
- Print maps and create PDF's for posting on website

Re-Draw Precinct Boundaries

- Discuss possibilities of potential change with the Board and Election Commission
- Based on needs, change precinct boundaries as recommended by Board and Election Commission
- Print maps and create PDF's for posting on website

PHASE II

Legal Defense (If Necessary)

- Work with County Attorney to assist in litigation
- Provide information requested by Court
- Testify as expert witness for the County

COST ESTIMATES:

Phase I - \$15,000 (Note: Cost was \$20,000 in 2011)

Phase II - The work performed shall be charged on an hourly basis according to the following rate schedule:

Technician	\$50.00 per hour
Planner	\$85.00 per hour
Senior Planner	\$115.00 per hour
