**ORDER APPOINTING AND SETTING SALARY OF
DEPUTY COURT ADMINISTRATOR**

There having come on for consideration the matter of the appointment of the deputy court administrator of District Eleven Chancery Court, it is hereby ordered by the undersigned Chancellor that Susan Edgar is hereby appointed to the position of Deputy Court Administrator for Judge James C. Walker of the 11th Chancery Court District. It is further ordered that the salary of said Court Administrator, Susan Edgar, is hereby set at \$50,000.00 per year, plus benefits effective August 15, 2016 pursuant to the AOC Trial Court Support Staff Salary Ranges. Said salary shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.

The salary of said Deputy Court Administrator shall be funded on a monthly basis, first by application from the AOC support staff funds of Chancellor James C. Walker and then from the funds of Madison County, Leake County, Holmes County, and Yazoo County, to be prorated as follows:

Madison County	60%
Leake County	20%
Yazoo County	10%
Holmes County	10%






