
Enclosed is a Certificate of Coverage granting you coverage under the Mining Storm Water, Dewatering, and No Discharge General Permit. The General Permit was reissued on September 7, 2012, by the Permit Board on Environmental Quality. There are several changes in the new permit which are summarized on the attached Addendum. This is a summary and does not cancel the need for the coverage recipient to carefully read and be familiar with the permit and its conditions.

The Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) appears to meet permit requirements and will be further reviewed during compliance inspections.

An important condition that is often overlooked is the requirement to request termination of coverage once the project has been completed and stabilized. Failure to submit the "Request for Termination of Coverage" form is a permit violation and subject to enforcement action.

This permit coverage is issued in accordance with the provisions of the Mississippi Air and Water Pollution Control Law (Sections 49-17-1, et seq., Mississippi code of 1972), and the regulations and standards adopted and promulgated thereunder and under the authority granted to the Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board pursuant to Section 402(b) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act. Any appeal of this action must be made within the 30-day period provided for in Section 49-17-29(4)(b) Mississippi code of 1972.

ADDENDUM

The following is a summary of changes from the previous Mining Storm Water, Dewatering, and No Discharge General Permit. These changes reflect EPA requirements and regulations, clarify existing language, requirements and conditions, and contain measures to reduce administrative burden. The changes are listed in no particular order.

This is a summary and does not cancel the need for the coverage recipient to carefully read and be familiar with the general permit and its conditions.

- Several allowable non storm water discharges have been added. They are: waterline flushing, landscape irrigation, diverted stream flows, dust suppression water and vehicle washing where detergents are not used (Activity 2).
- An annual submittal of the monthly inspections is now required, rather than the semi-annual submittal required by the previous permit (Activity 8).
- Employee training (specifically how to stay in permit compliance) is now a requirement (Activity 13).
- New requirements for the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP):
 - Construction exits are required if trucks are leaving the mining site and moving directly onto a paved, public road.
 - Sedimentation basins must have a surface discharge.
 - Housekeeping practices require spill and leak response and clean up procedures and construction/mining equipment should have exposure to storm water minimized (Activity 5).
- Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) language has been up-dated and 303(d) language has been added (Activity 2).

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your Notice of Exempt Operation received on May 13, 2016. **In the event this operation exceeds four (4) acres, you will be required to obtain a state mining permit.**

In addition to a Notice of Exempt Operation, you must apply for and obtain coverage under a Mining Storm Water General NPDES Permit prior to any mining activities at this site. Operating without a Storm Water Permit is a violation of the Mississippi State Law, Sections 49-17-1 through 49-17-43, which provides for significant monetary penalties. 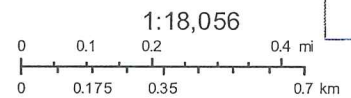
