Subject: Authority to run ad in Madison County Journal concerning recycling and disposal of white goods and old tires

Dear Board Members:

Madison County's drop-off bin recycling program begins January 1. The board approved ordering four recycling bins. Bins are scheduled to be delivered to the Yandell Road and Southwest Fire Stations on January 1. A bin will also be placed at the Stribling Road Fire Station as soon as a concrete pad has been poured for it by the Road Department. The location for the fourth bin has yet to be determined.

Information about the recycling bin locations has been placed on the county's website. I would also recommend running an ad in the January 5 edition of the *Madison County Journal*. Additionally, Supervisor Paul Griffin at a recent meeting brought up the idea of advertising about proper disposal of white goods and old tires. I recommend including that information in the same ad.

I sent a draft ad to *The Journal* today and expect to have a proof back in time to either add a copy under this agenda item or hand out prior to the start of Tuesday's board meeting.

RECYCLING

On January 1, Madison County switched from curbside recycling to drop-off bin recycling. Drop-off recycling bins are being located at the following locations:

- Yandell Road Fire Station, 114 Yandell Rd
- · Southwest Fire Station, 141 Lake Cavalier Rd
- Stribling Road Fire Station, 520 Stribling Rd (by Jan. 15)
- An additional location will be announced in the near future Materials that can be placed in the recycle bins are paper, cardboard, plastics, and aluminum. Glass is not allowed.
 Please do not dispose of garbage, furniture, old mattresses, or animal carcasses in or around the recycling bins.

WHITE GOODS

Madison County's contract with Waste Management provides for pickup of white goods, including stoves, ovens, washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, hot water heaters, dishwashers, microwaves, and other appliances. Residents can place white goods by the street along with their garbage for pickup by Waste Management. The EPA requires that appliances that contained Freon be tagged that the Freon has been removed prior to disposal.
