Madison County Recreational Trails Program Project

WHEREAS, the Madison County Board of Supervisors supports the grant application made to the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks for the Federal Recreational Trails Grant Program. The application is to construct .75 miles of paved trails for the Sulphur Springs Park.
