Dear Mr. Gaillet:

Texas Eastern Transmission, LP ("Texas Eastern") with its principal place of business located at 5400 Westheimer Court, Houston, TX 77056, is an interstate natural gas transmission company that maintains and operates interstate pipelines extending from the State of Texas and offshore Louisiana through the Appalachian area to the Eastern Seaboard in the Philadelphia and New York areas, and is subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") under the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. SS 717-717w).

Texas Eastern is preparing to alter a portion of its natural gas transmission pipeline facilities in Madison County, Mississippi under Texas Eastern's Part 157 blanket construction certificate, Docket No. CP82-535-000, issued November 5, 1982. The alteration is necessary to comply with USDOT regulations for operation of natural gas pipelines.

Specifically, Texas Eastern proposes to replace approximately 1047 feet of its thirty inch pipeline identified as Line # 14 and approximately 1038 feet of its thirty inch pipeline identified as Line # 18 within the existing easement on your property. A location map of the proposed project is included with this correspondence. The construction is planned for the first quarter of 2017.

Texas Eastern will be installing the aforementioned proposed facilities under the following existing pipeline easements:

A Texas Eastern representative will be contacting you to explain the specifics of the project and to answer any questions that you may have. After construction, you will be contacted to negotiate the settlement on any damages, as per the terms of the easement if such discussion is necessary. Typically, these damages would tend to be in the form of crop damages and are generally based upon the average yields and the fair market value for the various crops that are destroyed.

This project is being proposed under the automatic authorization requirements of the blanket certificate program administered by the Commission. To assist in answering any questions you may have you can call the Commission's Dispute Resolution Service (DRS) Helpline toll free at 1-877-337-2237 or by e-mail at ferc.adr@ferc.gov. The DRS Helpline is available in the event a person has concerns about a proposed automatic authorization project that cannot be resolved by discussion with the company.

Texas Eastern's intent is to conduct its activities on your property with due care. All lands disturbed during the construction will be restored to a condition, as near as practical, to that which existed prior to construction. Should you have any environmental mitigation problems or concerns during construction of this project, you may contact Wayne Carson at the phone number in the final paragraph.
