

We plan to host several fund raisers annually to secure funds to help us purchase the food needed to feed our clients daily.


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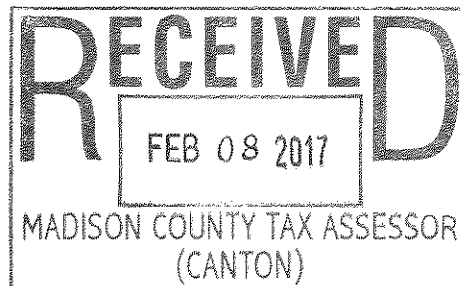
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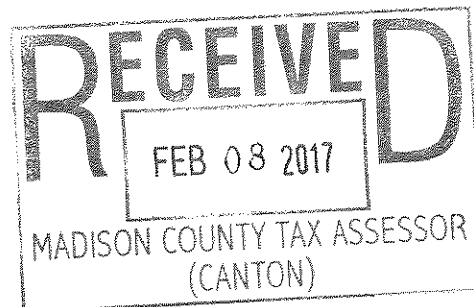

History of Our Daily Bread Ministries

Our Daily Bread Ministries started 15 years ago operating on the same principles that the Jackson Stewpot in Jackson, MS in response to a need in this part of Madison County. It was the original agreement of the board to plant the seed and get the program established and then turn over the ownership to the local community. This would take place within a 5-year period. That time arrived February of 2002, hence the "Cutting of the Apron Strings" and the new name "Our Daily Bread Ministries."

At our Daily Bread, we send out 120 meals daily to elderly and/or disabled people on our meals on wheels program and another 98 meals to those that come into the facility to eat and fellowship. We also give Christmas baskets, which consists of everything needed to prepare a holiday meal and hold an annual toy drive for children who otherwise might not receive any during the holidays.

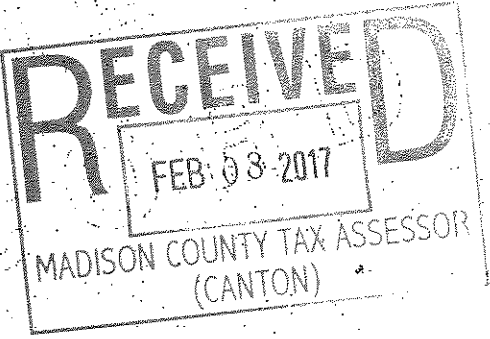

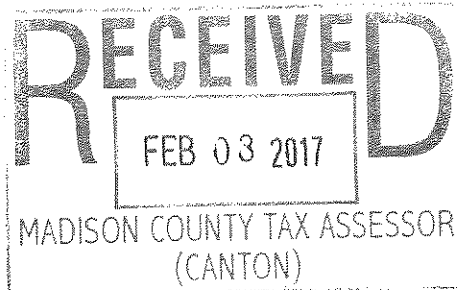

4. Rights-of-way and easements for roads, power lines and other utilities and restrictive covenants of record.

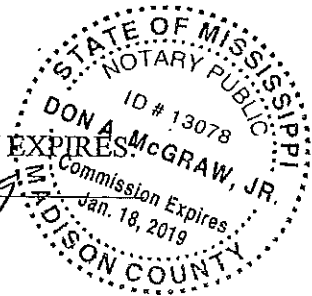

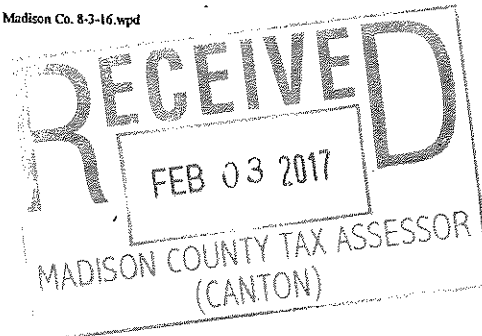
