Introduction and Attendance

The first regular monthly meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Madison, Mississippi was held on Tuesday, January 6, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Municipal Courtroom at the Madison Justice Complex. Those present were Mayor Mary Hawkins Butler, Aldermen Warren Strain, Tawanna Tatum, Patricia Peeler, Ken Jacobs, Mike Hudgins, Steve Hickok and Guy Bowering, City Attorney John Hedglin, City Clerk/Director Finance and Administration Susan Crandall and Deputy Clerk Mae Hardy.

Mayor Mary Hawkins Butler called the meeting to order. After the invocation by Alderman Jacobs and the Pledge of Allegiance led by Alderman Bowering, the meeting proceeded as follows:

ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF HERRON STREET OFF OLD MAIN STREET TO PICKENPAUGH LANE – ADOPTED

Mayor Mary Hawkins Butler said due to the rerouting of Main Street there remains a section of Herron Street north of old Main Street. She recommended this street be renamed in honor of Robert Pickenpaugh. The Mayor recognized City Attorney John Hedglin who presented an Ordinance. He explained this document will be used to officially notify 911 and Madison County. Alderman Strain moved to adopt the Ordinance to Change the Name of Herron Street Off Old Main Street to Pickenpaugh Lane. Alderman Bowering seconded the motion and approval was unanimous. The Mayor declared the motion carried. The Ordinance is incorporated herein by reference and attached hereto as **Exhibit V.**
