Sealed bids will be received by the County of Madison, Attention: Ronny Lott until **2:00 p.m. on October XX, 2017** in the offices of Madison County Board of Supervisors, 125 West North Street, Canton, Mississippi 39046 for the Tisdale Road Improvements project. At that time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.

The project generally consists of the reconstruction of approximately 1,350 linear feet of two-lane asphalt paved roadway, base repairs and asphalt overlay of approximately 5,950 linear feet of two-lane roadway, and minor drainage improvements.
