A sink hole has formed due to the failure of a 72" storm water system that carries roadway storm water from Bienville Drive to a detention pond within Belle Terre Subdivision.

The Engineering Department has determined that the pipe has separated which is causing water to back up on Bienville Drive and creating a dangerous sink hole.

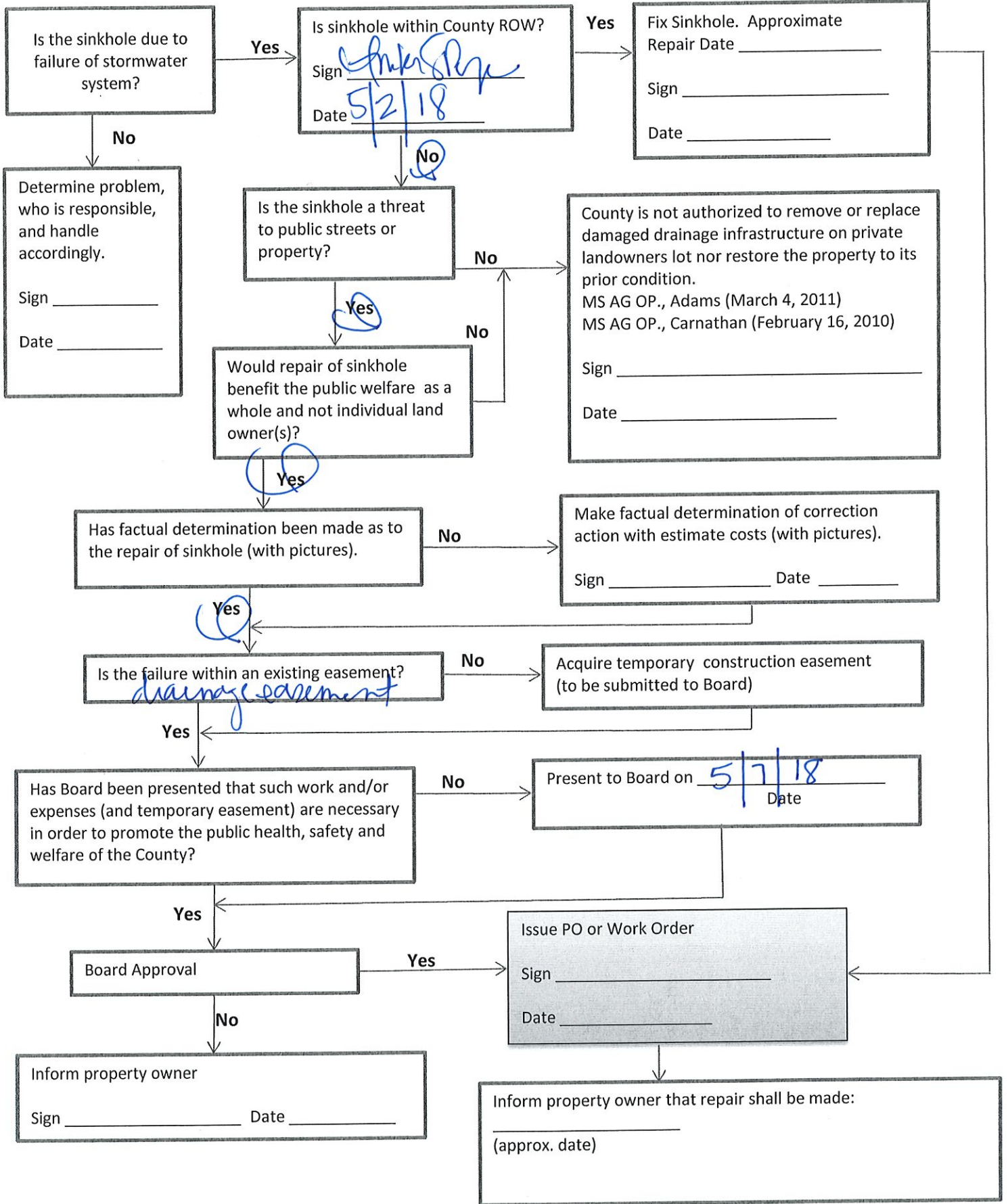
Therefore, it is in the best interest of the County and the public's health, safety and welfare to make the repairs, due to:

- Pipe has failed restricting flow off the roadway; and
- A dangerous sink hole has formed due to pipe failure.

Furnish, Backfill and compact area that has eroded.
Furnish and install up to 2 pallets of Bermuda Sod.

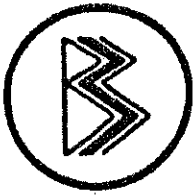
