**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
 Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Section 65-7-121 of the Mississippi Code, the Madison County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on May 21, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. in the Supervisor's Board Room of the Madison County Office Complex, 125 West North Street, Canton, Madison County, Mississippi, for the purpose of allowing public comment on the question of whether or not to abandon a portion of Rose Dale Road, a public county road located in Madison County, Mississippi, and being more particularly described as follows to wit:

**PROPOSED TERMINATION POINT OF ROSE DALE ROAD**

The following description is based on the Mississippi State Plane Coordinate System, West Zone, NAD 83/93, NAVD88, grid values, using a combined scale factor of 0.9999607804 and a ground to grid angle of N 00°15'13"W developed at the Point of Commencement, being derived using the University of Southern Mississippi's RTK/VRS network, said point having a value of N:1138628.93, E: 2441414.64 and Z:365 on said coordinate system. Commencing at the southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the South-

west Quarter of Section 11, Township 9 North, Range 4 East, Madison County, Mississippi, said point being represented by a 6" x 6" concrete monument (said monument at the southwest corner of a 1 acre cemetery and chain link fence); thence run N 90°00'00" E a distance of 35.00 feet to a point; thence run N 00°00'00" E a distance of 1334.70 feet to a 1/2" capped rebar set in the center of Rose Dale Road at the point of its intersection with and old crossing fence, said point being the proposed Termination Point of Rose Dale Road, and having a value of N:1141487.97, E:2441442.89 on the above referenced coordinate system. It is the intent of the above described Termination Point to be the most northern end of Rose Dale Road, which is approximately 865 feet, more or less, along and northerly of its beginning at the end of Billbrew Road which is a point being 2980 feet (0.564 miles), more or less, from Billbrew Road's center line intersection with Robinson Road, which has a value of N:1137631.31, E:2441400.61 on the above referenced coordinate system. It is the intent of the Madison County Board of Supervisors to ABANDON any interest Madison County has, or may have acquired in serving the public interest, to that portion of Rose Dale Road lying NORTH of the Termination Point described above.
