NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Section 65-7-121 of the Mississippi Code, the Madison County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on May 21, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. in the Supervisor's Board Room of the Madison County Office Complex, 125 West North Street, Canton, Madison County, Mississippi, for the purpose of allowing public comment on the question of whether or not to abandon a portion of Gross Road, a public county road located in Madison County, Mississippi, and being more particularly described as follows to wit:
PROPOSED TERMINATION POINT OF GROSS ROAD
A point in the center of Gross road at its intersection with the easterly right of way of the CN Railroad (50 feet from its centerline), being located near the center of Section 33, Township 8 North, Range 2 East, Madison County, Mississippi, being further described as follows:
Commencing at the intersection of the Gross Road centerline with the centerline of U.S. Highway 51, thence run westerly along the centerline of Gross Road 1240 feet, more or less, to its turn to the left; thence run southerly along its centerline 1240 feet, more or less, to its intersection with the easterly right of way line of the CN Railroad, being 50 feet from its centerline, said point being the herein proposed **Point of Terminus** of Gross Road; said point lies in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 33. It is the intent of the above described **Termination Point** to be the most westerly and/or southerly end of Gross Road, which is 2480 feet (0.57 miles), more or less, from its intersection with U.S. Highway 51.
IT IS THE INTENT of the Madison County Board of Supervisors to **ABANDON** any interest Madison County has, or may have acquired in serving the public interest, to that portion of Gross lying WEST of the Termination Point described above.
