NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Section 65-7-121 of the Mississippi Code, the ~~Madison~~ Madison County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on May 21, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. in the Supervisor's Board Room of the Madison County Office Complex, 125 West North Street, Canton, Madison County, Mississippi, for the purpose of allowing public comment on the question of whether or not to abandon a portion of Church Road, a public county road located in Madison County, Mississippi, and being more particularly described as follows to wit:
PROPOSED ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF CHURCH ROAD, MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI
The following description is based on the Mississippi State Plane Coordinate System, West Zone, NAD 83/93, NAVD88, grid values, using a combined scale factor of 0.9999453563 and a ground to grid angle of N 00°07'19"W developed at the Point of Commencement, being derived using the University of Southern Mississippi's RTK/VRS network, said point having a value of N:1102730.36, E:2366567.11 and Z:302 on said coordinate system. Commencing at the corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21 of Township 8 North, Range 2 East, Madison County, Mississippi, said point being represented by a "PK" nail found in the asphalt road (see survey of 16th School Section in the plat cabinets of Madison County's Chancery Clerk's office for more details concerning this corner), thence run South 00°00'22" West a distance of 4498.70 feet to a point for reference, said point being North 89°59'38" West, 20.8 feet from a concrete right of way marker found at the northern most point of intersection of the original Church Road with its recent extension which turns easterly to Calhoun Parkway, (see description of 5.35 acre right of way tract found in Deed Book 2619, Page 147); thence continue South 00°00'22" West a distance of 100.82 feet to a point in the center of the old Church Road at its intersection with an extension of the south right of way line of the recent extension easterly, bearing South 89°58'20" West, 75.0 feet from a 1/2" rebar (N:1098130.76, E:2366641.86, Z:287) found at its point of tangency to a curve to the southeast and being the Point of Beginning of the herein described parcel:
From the Point of Beginning, parcel shall lie left and right of the following course and extend easterly and westerly from said course to include any area by which Madison County may have acquired an interest in, during its long time maintenance and improvement of said original Church Road (pre December 2010), said course being along the center of said road as it exists this day (April, 2018) and an extension thereof, South 00°00'22" West a distance of 356.45 feet to the westerly right of way of Calhoun Parkway, being the Point of Terminus of said parcel, said point witnessed by a concrete right of way marker (N:1097823.16, N:2886590.28, Z:278) bearing North 25°55'03" East for 54.23 feet, and a 1/2" rebar (N:1097721.36, E:2366540.81, Z:276) bearing South 25°55'03" West for 58.96 feet, found at the northern most corner of that certain right of way tract acquired from the St. Joseph Catholic Church as found in Deed Book 2399, Page 182, said parcel situated in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 20, and the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 8 North, Range 2 East, Madison County in the Great State of Mississippi.
It is the intent of the Madison County Board of Supervisors to ABANDON any interest Madison County has, or may have acquired in serving the public interest to that portion of the origin-
