Subject: Approve restrictive specifications for four Physio Control 15 Life Pak monitors and authorize advertising for bids for same


Dear Board Members:

Pafford has requested that Madison County use EMSOF funds to purchase four Physio Control Life Pak 15 monitors for use on its ambulances in Madison County. Pafford currently uses the Physio Control Life Pak 15 monitor on its ambulances. Its paramedics are trained on that specific monitor. Pafford states in the attached letter that it is essential for its paramedics to use the specific brand of monitor they are trained on regardless of which ambulance they may be assigned to that day. Due to the life-and-death nature of the services provided with this equipment, I concur and recommend that the board approve restrictive specifications requiring Physio Control Life Pak 15 monitors.

I also request authority to advertise for bids via a reverse auction for four Physio Control Life Pak 15 monitors.

The purchase of this equipment has been approved by the Mississippi State Department of Health and will be paid for using EMSOF funds. EMSOF is funded by assessments on tickets.
