The following information was obtained from the analysis of the sample. The sample was found to contain the following elements in the following amounts:

Element	Amount
Carbon	50.00%
Hydrogen	10.00%
Oxygen	40.00%

The molecular weight of the compound is 100.00 g/mol. The empirical formula is C₅H₁₀O₂. The compound is a colorless, odorless liquid. It is soluble in water and organic solvents. It is stable at room temperature and does not react with acids or bases.

WHAT DO WE REQUEST OF YOU?

- A. Venue to accommodate the number of participants you expect to attend in your area for approximately 5 to 6 hours.
With access to the Venue:
 - 1. Volunteer/s to open-up, assist with set-up as needed, clean-up, and close-up the venue site.
 - 2. Large Bar-B-Que Grill
 - 3. A place or containers to store cold beverages
 - 4. Seating area with tables for children to eat
- B. A responsible and reconcilable staff person (Coordinator – **PAID BY SOUTHERN FOUNDATION**) who will communicate information to you and from us as things progress toward making this project a success, as this person would be the key to success for this pilot program.
 - 1. **Coordinator:** Will perform duties for two hours per day beginning March 15, 2019 to July 31, 2019 (97 days - excludes Memorial Day and Independence Day Holidays)
 - 1a. **Coordinator Rate of Pay:** \$12.00 per hour
 - 1b. **Coordinator Duties:** Include but not limited to overseeing the planning and scheduling of the “Back To School Extravaganza”. This person will be the liaison between the Board of Supervisors in your county and Southern Foundation. He or she must have excellent time management and communication skills, a desire to work, be able to monitor, gather ethnic data and process reports at the end of the event program. The Coordinator must know and have basic computer skills and be able to carry out any other duties as assigned.
