

**ORDER APPOINTING ATTORNEY FOR REPRESENTATION OF
INDIGENT DEFENDANTS AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION**

THIS MATTER is before the Court regarding representation of indigent defendants, and with the Court Being aware of an order for such purpose entered in this Court on October 1, 1984, and an order entered for such purpose entered by this Court on September 15, 2014, and with the Court being aware that one assistant public defender position created by such orders remains vacant, the Court finds it is necessary to appoint an individual to such vacant position. Accordingly, and with the Court being fully advised in the premises, the Court further finds that until further order of the court, effective April 1, 2019, John Michael Duncan should be appointed as a public defender in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Mississippi and for such services he should receive the monthly sum of \$4,533.33, subject to income tax withholding and with no additional benefits, with the first payment to be due on April 30, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that effective April 1, 2019, John Michael Duncan shall be and hereby is appointed as a public defender in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Mississippi and for such services he shall received the monthly sum of \$4,533.33, subject to income tax withholding and with no additional benefits, with the first payment to be due on April 30, 2019.
