RE: Rouser Road Crossing
Madison County, MS

Dear Mr. Gaillet:

Thank you for recently meeting with the Little Dixie Landfill personnel to discuss a secondary crossing of Rouser Road near the intersection of North County Line Road. Rouser Road currently separates the Little Dixie Landfill from its soil borrow operation along the western-most 3000 feet of the road.

As discussed that day, Little Dixie Landfill is requesting permission to install a second crossing that will allow heavy equipment to traverse between the landfill and soil borrow pit. The approximate location of this crossing is shown on the attached Figure 1. The proposed crossing will require:

- Removal of trees and other barriers, including barriers that would limit the line of sight for oncoming traffic,
- Installation of locking gates to prevent unauthorized access to the landfill and/or borrow pit,
- Installation of signage to warn of a truck crossing and to remind our employees to stop before crossing Rouser Road.
- Stabilized entrances with proper stormwater conveyances, and
- Twenty foot-wide stabilized section of Rouser Road to accommodate the heavier construction vehicles. This stabilized section will not be restrictive to common traffic.

We appreciate your consideration of this request and hope that you find this request acceptable. Please feel free to give me a call if you have any questions or if you need any additional information.

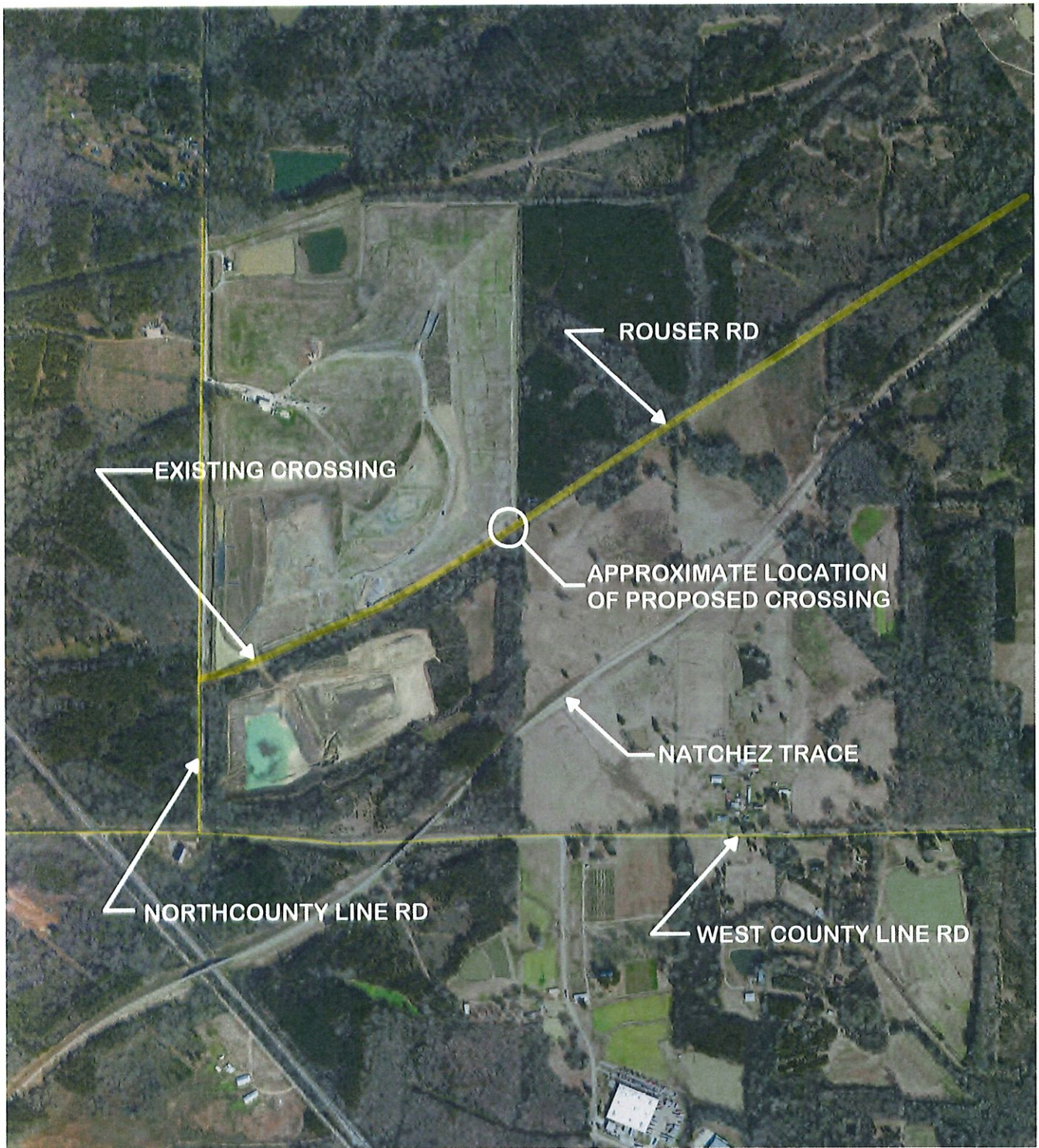
