We are seeking the names of individuals who will agree to serve on the aging advisory committee for Central Mississippi Planning and Development District. This committee will advise the District on matters relating to the identification of needs and the delivery of services for the aging population in the central Mississippi area. The purpose of this memorandum is to request your input into the formulation of this committee.

Representatives will be comprised from the seven-county area including Copiah, Hinds, Madison, Rankin, Simpson, Warren, and Yazoo counties. It is composed of twenty-one (21) members with each county having two (2) representatives and the City of Jackson has seven (7) representatives. The appointment period will begin in September 2019 through September 2021. Our meetings are held on a Quarterly basis during the day and last approximately two hours.

The Aging Advisory Committee must be composed of a diverse group of individuals; we are requesting that your nominee (s) fit the following criteria:

- Male or female, 60 years and older
- Minority Male or female, 60 years and older

Please submit your nomination(s) to us by Friday, August 16, 2019. The District's Board of Directors will make the final selection of members at its quarterly meeting on September 11, 2019. We know that you will nominate individuals who will help to enhance the leadership role of the District in our efforts to develop community-based services for our counties.
